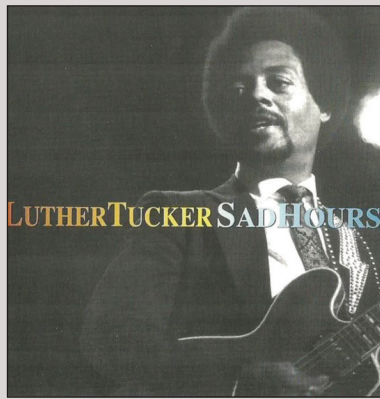


Birthday Blues

Luther Tucker born on January 20, 1936, Memphis, Tennessee. At age 7 Luther's family moved to Chicago's South Side where his mother who played boogie woogie blues and guitar introduced young Luther to his new teachers -Big Bill Broonzy and Robert Jr. Lockwood. By age 15 Luther began touring with saxman J.T. "Big Boy" Brown. In 1952 he recorded "Blue Midnight" with Little Walter and continued to perform with Walter Jacobs for the next eight years recording classics like "Mellow Down Easy," "Keys To The Highway," "Last Night," and "Boom Boom (Out Go The Lights)." Tucker was in demand in the studio with Muddy Waters, Sonny Boy Williamson II, Otis Spann and more. Moving to the at Area in 1969 he recorded with John Lee Hooker. In the 80's touring with James Cotton and performed regularly at Antone's. In 1993 he recorded "Sad Hours" on the Antone's label but sadly a few weeks later just after returning from an Europe tour with Lowell Fulson, Luther Tucker died from an heart attack on June 18, 1993, Greenbrae, California.
