Birthday Blues

Allen Toussaint: "My music is homegrowr from the garden of New Orleans, music is everything to me short of breathing. Music also has a role to lift you up - not to be escapist but to take you out of misery." Writer, producer, songwriter, arranger, session pianist, solo artist, Allen Toussaint was born on January 14, 1938 in New Orleans. By age 7 he was playing piano and as a teen was in a band with Snooks Eaglin. Toussaint then worked with Earl King and next was hired by Dave Bartholomew for a Fats Domino and Smiley Lewis recording session. By 1960 he was producing records for the Mint label with hits like Jessie Hill's "Ooh Poo Pah Doo," Ernie K-Doe's "Mother-In-Law" and Benny Spellman's "Fortune Teller" and "Lipstick Traces." While on military leave in 1963, he recorded "Whipped Cream" that became a Herb Allpert hit in 1965

After his discharge, Toussaint's songs for Lee Dorsey's "Ride Your Pony," "Working In A Coal Mine" and "Everything I Do Gonna Be Funky (From Now On)" were a string of hits. Next, he produced The Meters in 1969. Finally Touissaint recorded his own album in 1971, "From A Whisper To A Scream." In 1975 he recorded his "Southern Nights" album which included "What Do You Want The Girl To Do." Toussaint continued producing for artists like Etta James, Albert King, Elvis Costello and Joe Cocker plus formed his own label.
