Birthday Blues

Freddie King - "The Texas Cannonball" was born or September 3, 1934 in Gilmer, Texas and died at age 42 on December 28, 1976 in Dallas. At age six, his mother and brother began teaching him guitar and ten years later, the family moved from Dallas to Chicago's southside where he soon discovered Muddy Waters, Howlin' Wolf, Elmore James, Little Walter Eddie Taylor, Robert Lockwood, Jr., T-Bone Walker, Jimmy Rogers and many others while working in the steel mills and gigging at night. In 1952 he married Jessie Burnett from Texas. Freddie King's first blues band was Every Hour Blues Boy with Jimmie Lee Robinson (guitar) and Sonny Scott (drums). King began recording on the Parrot label in 1953 and in 1960 signed with the King/Federal label where he recorded his big hits, "Have You Ever Loved A Woman," and "Hide Away" that reached number five on Billboard's rhythm & blues chart in 1961. Soon he was



touring with his brother, Benny Turner, on bass and his valet/driver Tyrone Davis and with Jackie Wilson, Sam Cook and James Brown. Freddie's love of Chicago's all-night bars and gambling drove his wife to move back to Texas with their six children and Freddie joined them in 1963. In 1968 he singed with Cotillion, an Atlantic subsidiary label, and in 1969 with Leon Russell's Shelter label where he recorded "Going Down" in 1971. He began touring often with rock musicians like his friend Eric Clapton and signed on Clapton's label, RSO. Besides Eric Clapton, Freddie influenced Stevie Ray Vaughan, Peter Green, Mick Taylor, Lonnie Mack and many others. In 1982 Freddie King was inducted into the Blues Hall of Fame and in 2012 into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame.
