## **Birthday Blues**

Rosalie Hill - This North Mississippi Hills Blues singer and guitarist was born on September 25, 1910, in Como, Mississippi located in the North Mississippi Hill Country and died at age 58 on October 22, 1968, Senatobia, Mississippi. Rosalie Hill (Rose Lee) was the daughter of Hill Country's blind musical patriarch Sid Hemphill. Rosalie's two sisters - Sidney and Virgie - also played as well as her niece Jesse Mae Hemphill (Virgie's daughter). Rosalie's father taught her to play guitar at age 6 and began performing at dances with her father by age 10. When her father died in 1961. Rosalie stopped playing for a few years to work as a sharecropper with her husband. When their home burned down, they moved to a shack. All of her life she lived in poverty. In 2006 Fat

Possum records reissued her record Rosa Lee Hill and Friends.


